Gold Band was not possible this year for those reasons. Administration provided a different model-offering a Freshman band in the 2nd semester, not ability based, will hold auditions for seats. Freshmen will default to that class in the 2nd semester next year. Band will be a full year commitment (Marching and Concert). The course descriptions have been updated to reflect the band offerings, and it is much more clear. Directors are very encouraged with this direction.
